The one who likes Owl lives on an even numbered floor. Only three persons live between the one who likes Cuckoo and the one who likes Penguin. T lives immediately above R. T does not like Penguin. Only two persons live between Q and the one who likes Patoo. The one who likes Patoo live below the floor on which Q lives. W likes Sparrow and lives on floor no. 8. The one who likes Parrot does not live immediately above or immediately below Q. S does not live immediately above or immediately below P. X likes Stork and he lives immediately above W. V does not like Crane.

Step III: 363 around 131 87 power tide union 79 parle 252 park 584

Step IV: parle 363 around 131 87 tide union 79 252 park 584 power

Step V: 795 parle 363 around 131 tide union 252 park 584 power 876

Step VI: tide 795 parle 363 around 131 252 park 584 power 876 union

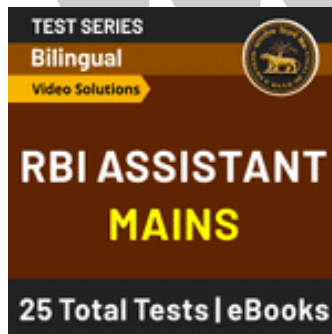
(I) Good social welfare law. It is initially for girls as they are comparatively disadvantaged. Hopefully it will soon be followed by free education for everyone.

(III) Do not differentiate a poor or average person on gender. A poor boy or man should also get free education as well.

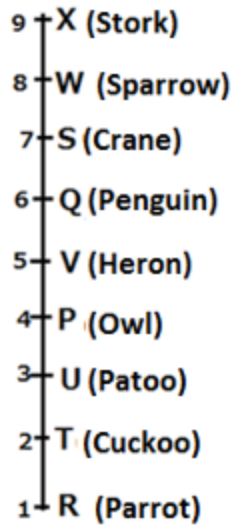

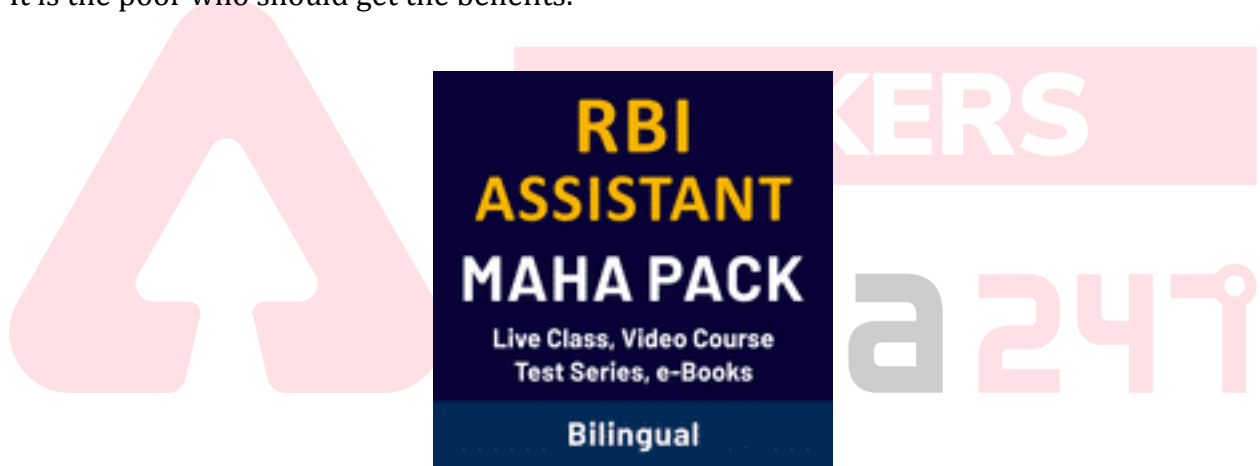
