1. **Embezzlement (noun)**

**Meaning;** The fraudulent conversion of property from a property owner.



**Synonyms:** fraud, theft

**Antonyms:** honest, return

2. **Tranquility (noun)**

**Meaning;** the state of being tranquil, the absence of disturbance; peacefulness



**Synonyms:** calmness

**Antonyms:** chaos

3. **Vanquish (verb)**

**Meaning;** To defeat, to overcome



**Synonyms:** defeat, conquer

**Antonyms:** surrender, lose

4. **Encrust (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cover with a hard crust.



**Synonyms:** cover, hide

**Antonyms:** reveal, strip

5. **Bungler (noun)**

**Meaning;** Someone who makes mistakes because of incompetence.



**Synonyms:** inept

**Antonyms:** expert

6. **Spook (verb)**

**Meaning;** To frighten



**Synonyms:** terrify, horrify

**Antonyms:** calm, please

7. **Supine (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Reluctant to take action due to indifference



**Synonyms:** inactive

**Antonyms:** proactive
