1. **Wily (adjective)**

Meaning; sly, cunning, full of tricks

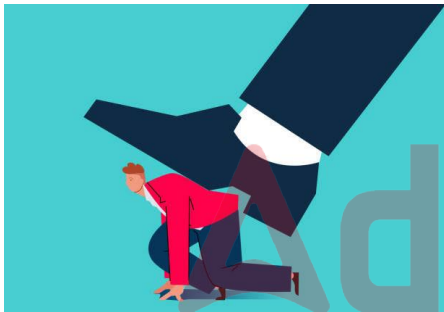


Synonyms: clever, canny

Antonyms: ignorant, naive

2. **Gargantuan (adjective)**

Meaning; Huge; immense; tremendous



Synonyms: enormous, gigantic

Antonyms: small, minute

3. **Enscence (verb)**

Meaning; To place in a secure environment.



Synonyms: establish, install

Antonyms: displace, abolish

4. **Usurp (verb)**

Meaning; To seize power from another, usually by illegitimate means.



Synonyms: seize, expropriate

Antonyms: give, surrender

5. **Unremitting (adjective)**

Meaning; never slackening



Synonyms: ceaseless, enduring

Antonyms: ending, discontinuous

6. **Furlough (noun)**

Meaning; A leave of absence or vacation



Synonyms: recess, break

Antonyms: recall, travail

7. **Conundrum (noun)**

Meaning; A difficult question or riddle



Synonyms: dilemma

Antonyms: solution
