1. **Tally (noun)**

Meaning; To count something.



Synonyms: calculate

Antonyms: miscalculate

2. **Reticence (noun)**

Meaning; a silent and reserved nature



Synonyms: reluctance

Antonyms: frankness

3. **Clinch (verb)**

Meaning; To hold firmly; to clench



Synonyms: hold

Antonyms: release

4. **Summon (verb)**
Meaning; To call people together



Synonyms: convene
Antonyms: cancel

5. **Peevish (adjective)**
Meaning; Easily annoyed, especially by things that are not important; irritable,



Synonyms: irritable
Antonyms: affable

6. **Clemency (noun)**
Meaning; The gentle or kind exercise of power; leniency, mercy



Synonyms: mercy
Antonyms: cruelty

7. **Shoddy (adjective)**
Meaning; Of poor quality or construction



Synonyms: worthless
Antonyms: reputed
