1. **Wily (adjective)**

Meaning; sly, cunning, full of tricks



Synonyms: clever, canny

Antonyms: ignorant, naive

2. **Gnaw (verb)**

Meaning; To produce excessive anxiety or worry.



Synonyms: torture, trouble

Antonyms: soothe, aid

3. **Disenchantment (noun)**

Meaning; Disillusionment



Synonyms: Dissatisfaction, Discontent

Antonyms: content, pleased

4. **Ablution (noun)**

Meaning; The act of washing or cleansing the body



Synonyms: clean

Antonyms: pollution

5. **Corpus (noun)**

Meaning; A collection of writings, a body, a collection.



Synonyms: compilation, collection

Antonyms: sole, individual

6. **Smidgen (noun)**

Meaning; A very small quantity or amount.



Synonyms: bit

Antonyms: lot

7. **Perfunctory (adjective)**

Meaning; Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless or indifferent manner



Synonyms: careless

Antonyms: careful
