

VOCABULARY

1. **Entwine (verb)**

Meaning; To twist or twine around something



Synonyms: entangle, twist

Antonyms: unwind, untwist

2. **Coax (verb)**

Meaning; To wheedle, persuade



Synonyms: persuade, tempt

Antonyms: discourage, repulse

3. **Procurement (noun)**

Meaning; The act of procuring or obtaining; obtainment



Synonyms: attainment

Antonyms: renouncement

4. **Quell (noun)**

Meaning; To subdue, to put down; to silence or force (someone) to submit

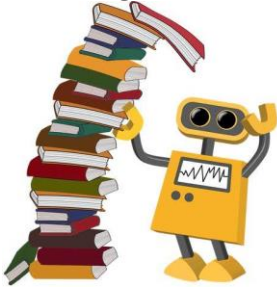


Synonyms: crush, finish

Antonyms: ignite, initiate

5. **Topple (verb)**

Meaning; to totter and fall



Synonyms: fall, overturn

Antonyms: balance, fixed

6. **Deploy (Verb)**

Meaning; To prepare and arrange (usually military unit or units) for use.



Synonyms: utilise, use

Antonyms: destroy, neglect

7. **Stash (verb)**

Meaning; To hide or store away for later use.



Synonyms: conceal, smuggle

Antonyms: reveal, expose
