

VOCABULARY

1. **Contrite (adjective)**

Meaning; Sincerely penitent or feeling regret or sorrow



Synonyms: remorseful, regretful

Antonyms: unrepentant, ignorant

2. **Stodgy (adjective)**

Meaning; Dull, old-fashioned



Synonyms: monotonous, uninteresting

Antonyms: entertainment, interesting

3. **Vexatious (Adjective)**

Meaning; Causing vexation or annoyance; teasing; troublesome.



Synonyms: irksome, annoying

Antonyms: pleasing, aiding

4. **Reckon (verb)**

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: estimate, consider

Antonyms: refuse, avoid

5. **Gloat (verb)**

Meaning; To triumph, crow, relish, glory



Synonyms: rejoice, relish

Antonyms: sympathise, unhappy

6. **Agape (Adjective)**

Meaning; In a state of astonishment, wonder



Synonyms: breathless

Antonyms: indifferent

7. **Dodder (verb)**

Meaning; To shake or tremble



Synonyms: stagger, stumble

Antonyms: stay, remain
