1. **Excruciating (adjective)**

Meaning; Causing great pain or anguish, agonizing

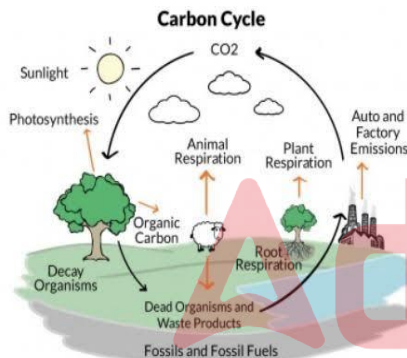


Synonyms: disturbing, irritating

Antonyms: pleasing, soothing

2. **Iteration (noun)**

Meaning; Recital or performance a second time; repetition.



Synonyms: repetition, replay

Antonyms: irregularity, rareness

3. **Pared (verb)**

Meaning; to remove the outer covering



Synonyms: slash, cut

Antonyms: raise, grow

4. **Implacable (adjective)**

Meaning; Not able to be placated or appeased



Synonyms: unplacable, unpleasable

Antonyms: appeasable, assuageable

5. **Obdurate (adjective)**

Meaning; Stubbornly persistent



Synonyms: stubborn

Antonyms: compliant

6. **Wade (verb)**

Meaning; to walk through water or something that impedes progress.



Synonyms: paddle

Antonyms: dodge

7. **Warhorse (noun)**

Meaning; An experienced person who has been through many battles, situations or contests



Synonyms: certified, adequate

Antonyms: incapable, inadequate
