

VOCABULARY

1. Altruist (noun)

Meaning; A person showing behaviour that benefits other



Synonyms: benevolent, philanthropist

Antonyms: selfish, self centred

2. Scorn (verb)

Meaning; To feel or display contempt or disdain

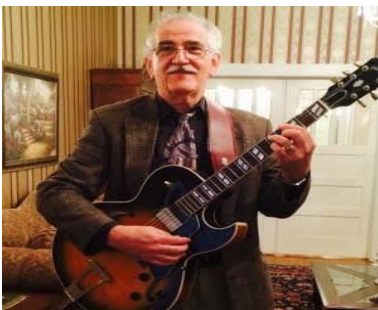


Synonyms: disrespect

Antonyms: respect

3. Mellow (adjective)

Meaning; subdued, soft, rich, delicate



Synonyms: melodious, Mellifluent

Antonyms: harsh, gruff

4. **Plaudit (noun)**

Meaning; A mark or expression of applause



Synonyms: commendation

Antonyms: criticism

5. **Stutter (verb)**

Meaning; To speak with a spasmodic repetition of vocal sounds.



Synonyms: stammer

Antonyms: fluent

6. **Incipient (adjective)**

Meaning; In an initial stage; beginning

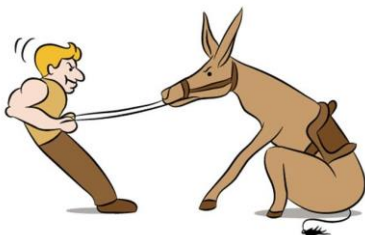


Synonyms: beginning, commencing

Antonyms: mature, developed

7. **Recalcitrant (adjective)**

Meaning; Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority.



Synonyms: unmanageable, stubborn

Antonyms: manageable, compliant
