**Antonyms:** brief, interrupted

2. **Incentive (noun)**

**Meaning;** Something that motivates, rouses, or encourages.



**Synonyms:** encouragement, boost

**Antonyms:** discouragement, disincentive

3. **Upend (verb)**

**Meaning;** To destroy, invalidate



**Synonyms:** tangled, disorganised

**Antonyms:** organised, ordered

4. **Gusting (verb)**

**Meaning;** Any rush or outburst



**Synonyms:** windy

**Antonyms:** calm

**5. Unsavoury (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Not savory; without flavor.



**Synonyms:** distasteful

**Antonyms:** tasteful

**6. Coax (verb)**

**Meaning;** To wheedle, persuade



**Synonyms:** persuade, tempt

**Antonyms:** discourage, repulse

**7. Meed (noun)**

**Meaning;** achievement; reward, deserts; award.



**Synonyms:** award
