### 1. Hovel (noun)

**Meaning;** A poor cottage; a small, mean house; a hut.



**Synonyms:** hut, slum

**Antonyms:** fort, bungalow

### 2. cite (verb)

**Meaning;** to quote; to repeat



**Synonyms:** reproduce, quote

**Antonyms:** withhold, conceal

### 3. Disenchantment (noun)

**Meaning;** Disillusionment



**Synonyms:** Dissatisfaction, Discontent

**Antonyms:** content, pleased

**4. waylay (verb)**

**Meaning;** To lie in wait for and attack from ambush.



**Synonyms:** ambushade

**Antonyms:** forward

**5. Perfunctory (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless or indifferent manner



**Synonyms:** careless

**Antonyms:** careful

**6. Tizzy (noun)**

**Meaning;** distress; a dither



**Synonyms:** annoyance

**Antonyms:** delight

**7. Mow (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cut down grass or crops.



**Synonyms:** trim

**Antonyms:** grow
