

VOCABULARY

1. **Precede (verb)**

Meaning: To go before, go in front of.

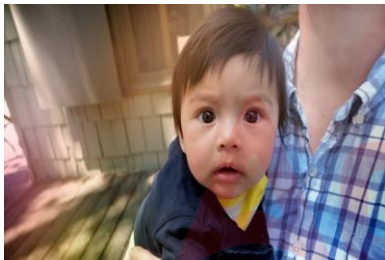


Synonyms: predate, preexist

Antonyms: follow, succeed

2. **Ogle (verb)**

Meaning: To stare at (someone or something), especially impertinently, amorously, or covetously.



Synonyms: stare

Antonyms: ignore

3. **Strew (verb)**

Meaning: To spread abroad; to disseminate



Synonyms: disperse, scatter

Antonyms: collect, concentrate

4. **Cadence (noun)**

Meaning; Balanced, rhythmic flow



Synonyms; beat, rhythm

Antonyms; chaotic, orderless

5. **Duress (noun)**

Meaning; Restraint in which a person is influenced, whether by lawful or unlawful forceful compulsion

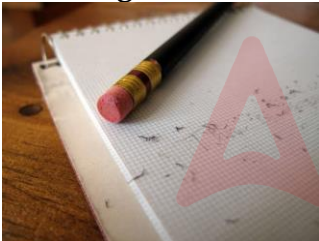


Synonyms: compulsion, enforcement

Antonyms: consent, approval

6. **Efface (verb)**

Meaning; To cause to disappear as if by rubbing out or striking out.



Synonyms; destroy, abolish

Antonyms; retain, protect

7. **Recrimination (noun)**

Meaning; A counter or mutual accusation.



Synonyms: accusation, blame

Antonyms: acceptance, assent
