

VOCABULARY

1. **Repudiate (verb)**

Meaning; To refuse to have anything to do with; to disown.



Synonyms: abandon, deny

Antonyms: accept, approve

2. **Lackadaisical (adjective)**

Meaning; Showing no interest, vigor, determination



Synonyms: lukewarm, half-hearted

Antonyms: enthusiastic, excited

3. **Ample (adjective)**

Meaning; Large; great in size, extent, capacity, or bulk;



Synonyms: abundant, plenty

Antonyms: limited, dearth

4. **Broach (verb)**

Meaning; To open, to make an opening into; to pierce.



Synonyms: raise, introduce

Antonyms: reserve, conceal

5. **Alacrity (noun)**

Meaning; Eagerness; liveliness; enthusiasm.



Antonyms; indifference, ignorance

Synonyms; eagerness, avidity

6. **Brunt (noun)**

Meaning; The full adverse effects; the chief consequences



Synonyms: stress, tension

Antonyms: relaxation, peace

7. **Dastardly (adjective)**

Meaning; in the manner of a dastard; marked by cowardice



Synonyms: evil, heinous

Antonyms: noble, nice
