1. **Dawdle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To spend (time) without haste or purpose.



**Synonyms:** delay, linger

**Antonyms:** expedite, hasten

2. **Splinter (verb)**

**Meaning;** To break, or cause to break, into factions.



**Synonyms:** split, fracture

**Antonyms:** join, combine

3. **Feverish (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Filled with excess energy



**Synonyms:** excited, restless

**Antonyms:** placid, tranquil

4. **Onslaught (noun)**

**Meaning;** A fierce attack.



**Synonyms:** attack, aggression

**Antonyms:** support, protection

5. **Subterranean (adjective)**

**Meaning;** below ground, under the earth, underground



**Synonyms:** subversive, covert

**Antonyms:** open, palpable

6. **Fillip (noun)**

**Meaning;** Something that excites or stimulates.



**Synonyms:** incitement, boost

**Antonyms:** discouragement, restraint

7. **Grandeur (noun)**

**Meaning;** The state of being grand or splendid; magnificence.



**Synonyms:** magnificence, greatness

**Antonyms:** ordinary, simple
