Abstruse (adjective) 1.

Meaning; Difficult to comprehend or understand



Synonyms: rarefied, obscure Antonyms: clear, evident

Calibrate (verb) 2.

Meaning; To check or adjust by comparison with a standard.



Synonyms: Determine, calculate

Antonyms: Approximate, Estimate

3. Spate (noun)

Meaning; A sudden rush or increase



Synonyms; flurry, succession

Antonyms; drip, trickle

4. Salubrious (adjective)

Meaning; Promoting health or well-being



Synonyms; medicinal, healthful **Antonyms;** unhealthy, harmful

5. Scramble (noun)

Meaning; A rush or hurry



Synonyms; struggle, tussle Antonyms; comfort, order

6. Incandescent (adjective)

Meaning; emitting light as a result of being heated or shining very brightly



Synonyms; bright, luminous

Antonyms; dark, dim

7. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: consider **Antonyms**: avoid
