

1. **Furlough (noun)**

Meaning; A leave of absence or vacation



Synonyms: recess, break

Antonyms: recall, travail

2. **Imprimatur (noun)**

Meaning; Any mark of official approval.



Synonyms: approval, permission

Antonyms: disapproval, reprobation

3. **Deceive (verb)**

Meaning; To trick or mislead.



Synonyms: fraud

Antonyms: honest

4. **Reprobate (noun)**

Meaning; An individual with low morals or principles



Synonyms: Villian, Wretch

Antonyms: virtuous, righteous

5. **Excoriate (verb)**

Meaning; To strongly denounce or censure.



Synonyms: criticise, denounce

Antonyms: laud, praise

6. **Uphill (adjective)**

Meaning; Difficult or laborious.



Synonyms: difficult, tough

Antonyms: easy, simple

7. **Haul (verb)**

Meaning; To draw or pull something heavy.



Synonyms: pull, drag

Antonyms: push, press
