

### 1. Plaintive (Adjective)

**Meaning;** Sounding sorrowful, mournful



**Synonyms:** mournful, wistful

**Antonyms:** joyful, euphoric

### 2. Embark(verb)

**Meaning;** To start, begin.



**Synonyms:** begin, enter

**Antonyms:** finish, terminate

### 3. Embattle (verb)

**Meaning;** To arrange in order of battle; to array for battle



**Synonyms:** strengthen, fort

**Antonyms:** weaken, debilitate

**4. Proclivity (noun)**

**Meaning:** A predisposition or natural inclination



**Synonyms:** like, affinity

**Antonyms:** dislike, hate

**5. Contrition (noun)**

**Meaning;** The state of being contrite; sincere penitence or remorse.



**Synonyms:** remorse

**Antonyms:** remorselessness

**6. Malapert (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Cheeky, impudent, saucy.



**Synonyms:** rude

**Antonyms:** modest

**7. Existent (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** existing; having life or being, current; occurring now



**Synonyms:** extant

**Antonyms:** nonexistent
