

1. **Sidele (verb)**

Meaning; To (cause something to) move sideways



Synonyms: sneak, slide

Antonyms: march, ride

2. **Attune (verb)**

Meaning; to bring into harmony or accord.



Synonyms: harmonize, acclimatize

Antonyms: disharmonize, destabilise

3. **Meed (noun)**

Meaning; achievement; reward, deserts; award.



Synonyms: award

Antonyms: disregard

4. **conceive (verb)**

Meaning; To develop an idea; to form in the mind; to plan; to devise; to originate

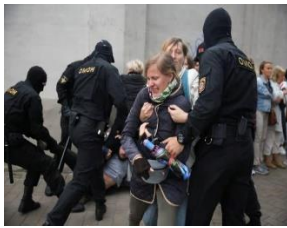


Synonyms: assume

Antonyms: neglect

5. **Purge (noun)**

Meaning; A forcible removal of people, for example, from political activity.

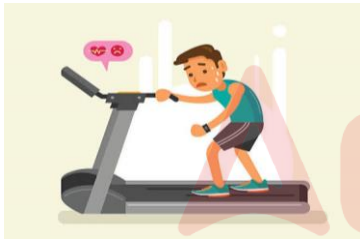


Synonyms: expulsion, termination

Antonyms: keep, hold

6. **Bout (noun)**

Meaning; A period of something, usually painful or unpleasant



Synonyms: stretch

Antonyms: stagnation

7. **Irrefutable (adjective)**

Meaning; undeniable; unable to be disproved or refuted



Synonyms: unquestionable

Antonyms: questionable
