1. **Obfuscate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To deliberately make more confusing



**Synonyms:** confuse

**Antonyms:** clarify

2. **Plunge (verb)**

**Meaning;** To thrust into water, or into any substance that is penetrable; to immerse.



**Synonyms:** dive, fall

**Antonyms:** ascend, rise

3. **Atrophy (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cause to waste away or become abortive; to starve or weaken.



**Synonyms;** decline, dwindle

**Antonyms;** flourish, strengthen

4. **Dawdle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To spend (time) without haste or purpose.



**Synonyms:** delay, linger

**Antonyms:** expedite, hasten

5. **Onslaught (noun)**

**Meaning;** A fierce attack.



**Synonyms:** attack, aggression

**Antonyms:** support, protection

6. **Wily (adjective)**

**Meaning;** sly, cunning, full of tricks



**Synonyms:** clever, canny

**Antonyms:** ignorant, naive

7. **Ablution (noun)**

**Meaning;** The act of washing or cleansing the body



**Synonyms:** clean

**Antonyms:** pollution
