1. **Exacerbate (verb)**

Meaning; To make worse (a problem, bad situation)



Synonyms: worsen, aggravate

Antonyms: pacify, hold

2. **Wrangle (noun)**

Meaning; To bicker, or quarrel



Synonyms: tussle, brawl

Antonyms: peace, harmony

3. **Scramble (noun)**

Meaning; A rush or hurry

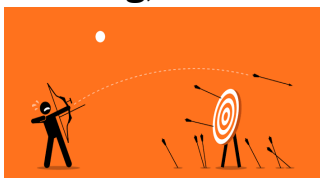


Synonyms: struggle, tussle

Antonyms: comfort, order

4. **Bungler (noun)**

Meaning; Someone who makes mistakes because of incompetence.



Synonyms: inept

Antonyms: expert

5. **Nab (verb)**

Meaning; To seize, arrest



Synonyms: arrest, seize

Antonyms: liberate, free

6. **Scuttle (verb)**

Meaning; denigrate or destroy one's position or property



Synonyms: destroy, sink

Antonyms: construct, save

7. **Petulant (adjective)**

Meaning; childishly irritable



Synonyms: irritable, cranky

Antonyms: cheerful, delightful
