### 1. Protege (noun)

**Meaning;** A person guided and protected by a more prominent person.



**Synonyms;** pupil, trainee

**Antonyms;** guardian, trainer

### 2. Logjam (noun)

**Meaning;** A clog or such jam or mess that halts or greatly delays progress.



**Synonyms:** stagnation, deadlock

**Antonyms:** advance, expedition

### 3. Ruckus (noun)

**Meaning;** A noisy disturbance and/or commotion.



**Synonyms:** disorder, turbulence

**Antonyms:** tranquil, peace

**4. Shamble (verb)**

**Meaning;** To walk while shuffling or dragging the feet.



**Synonyms:** Stride, tread

**Antonyms:** unmoving, immobile

**5. Expedition (noun)**

**Meaning;** A trip, especially a long one, made by a person or a group of people for a specific purpose



**Synonyms:** tour, mission

**Antonyms:** delay, tardiness

**6. Sullen (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Gloomy; dismal; foreboding



**Synonyms:** sulky, grumpy

**Antonyms:** cheerful, bright

**7. Rescind (verb)**

**Meaning;** To repeal, annul, or declare void



**Synonyms:** cancel, revoke

**Antonyms:** approve, enforce
