**Meaning;** Having a lively or volatile character

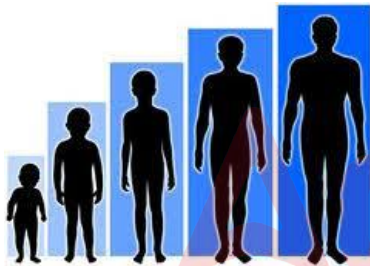


**Synonyms:** fickle, volatile

**Antonyms:** steady, stable

### 2. Spurt(noun)

**Meaning;** A sudden brief burst of, or increase in, speed, effort, activity, emotion or development.



**Synonyms:** rise, increment

**Antonyms:** diminish, decrease

### 3. Scrap (verb)

**Meaning;** To discard.



**Synonyms:** abolish, abandon

**Antonyms:** restore, have

4. **Quagmire (noun)**

**Meaning;** A perilous, mixed up and troubled situation



**Synonyms:** dilemma, predicament

**Antonyms:** solution, contentment

5. **Proffer (verb)**

**Meaning;** An offer made



**Synonyms:** propose, offer

**Antonyms:** reject, deny

6. **Rejuvenate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To render young again



**Synonyms:** renew, revive

**Antonyms:** worsen, deplete

7. **Trammel (noun)**

**Meaning;** Whatever impedes activity, progress



**Synonyms:** constraint, impediment

**Antonyms:** aid, assist
