1. Inundation (noun)

Meaning; The act of inundating; an overflow; a flood



Synonyms: flood **Antonyms**: drought

Impediment (noun) 2.

Meaning; A hindrance; that which impedes



Synonyms: hindrance, bottleneck

Antonyms: freedom, opening

Nonchalance (noun) 3.

Meaning; indifference; carelessness; coolness; disregard, detachment.



Synonyms: indifferent, casual **Antonyms**: concerned, sincere

4. Denigrate (verb)

Meaning; To criticise so as to besmirch; traduce, disparage or defame.



Synonyms: defame **Antonyms**: commend

Wrought (adjective) 5.


Meaning; Having been worked or prepared somehow.



Synonyms: fixed, specified **Antonyms**: common, ordinary

6. Anomaly (noun)

Meaning; A deviation from a rule



Synonyms: deviation, abnormality Antonyms: normality, regularity

Unwittingly (adverb) 7.

Meaning; In an unwitting manner; inadvertently, unintentionally



Synonyms: ignorantly **Antonyms**: knowingly
