1. Scunch (verb)

Meaning; To crumple and squeeze to make more compact.



Synonyms: compress, suppress

Antonyms: expand, ease

2. Lukewarm (adjective)

Meaning; Not very enthusiastic



Synonyms: chilled, unheated

Antonyms: warm, heated

3. Scurry (verb)

Meaning; To run with quick light steps, to scamper.



Scurry

Synonyms: scuttle, rash

Antonyms: stroll, crawl

4. **Fraught (adjective)**

Meaning; A load; a burden



Synonyms: laden, full

Antonyms: devoid, empty

5. **Extol(verb)**

Meaning; To praise



Synonyms: applaud, hail

Antonyms: criticise, denounce

6. **Allude(verb)**

Meaning; To refer to something



Synonyms: direct, mention

Antonyms: snub, disregard

7. **Idyllic (adjective)**

Meaning; Extremely happy, peaceful, or picturesque



Synonyms: pastoral

Antonyms: urban
