### 1. Whine (verb)

**Meaning;** To make a sound resembling such a cry.



**Synonyms:** moan

**Antonyms:** pleasure

### 2. Fawning (adjective)

**Meaning;** Seeking favor by way of flattery; flattering, servile



**Synonyms:** subservient, ingratiating

**Antonyms:** peremptory, domineering

### 3. Gutted (verb)

**Meaning;** With the most important parts destroyed



**Synonyms:** empty, ransacked

**Antonyms:** filled, prosperous

**4. Recuperate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To recover, especially from an illness



**Synonyms:** recover, improve

**Antonyms:** deteriorate, degrade

**5. Ensnore (verb)**

**Meaning;** To place in a secure environment.



**Synonyms:** establish, install

**Antonyms:** displace, abolish

**6. Maverick (noun)**

**Meaning;** Showing independence in thoughts or actions.



**Synonyms:** radical, dissenter

**Antonyms:** moderate

**7. Palatable (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Pleasing to the taste, tasty



**Synonyms:** attractive, pleasant

**Antonyms:** unpleasant, unacceptable
