1. Hoodwink (verb)

Meaning; To deceive by disguise

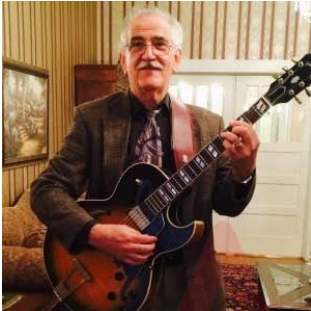


Synonyms: mislead, deceive

Antonyms: guide, protect

2. Mellow (adjective)

Meaning; subdued, soft, rich, delicate



Synonyms: melodious, Mellifluous

Antonyms: harsh, gruff

3. Plaudit (noun)

Meaning; A mark or expression of applause



Synonyms: commendation

Antonyms: criticism

4. **Stutter (verb)**

Meaning; To speak with a spasmodic repetition of vocal sounds.

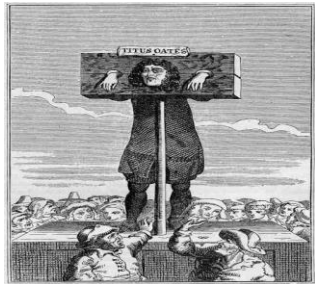


Synonyms: stammer

Antonyms: fluent

5. **Inordinate (Adjective)**

Meaning; Excessive; unreasonable or inappropriate in magnitude; extreme



Synonyms: excessive, unwarranted

Antonyms: modest, limited

6. **Tinker (verb)**

Meaning; To tinker with; to tweak or attempt to fix.



Synonyms: fix, improve

Antonyms: destroy, mess

7. **Succour (noun)**

Meaning; Aid, assistance, or relief



Synonyms: assist, aid

Antonyms: hurt, harm
