1. Mercurial (adjective)

Meaning; Having a lively or volatile character

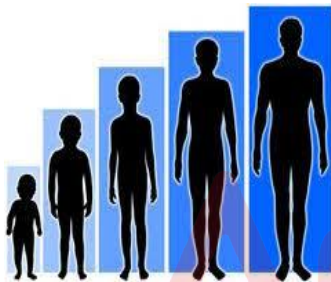


Synonyms: fickle, volatile

Antonyms: steady, stable

2. Spurt(noun)

Meaning; A sudden brief burst of, or increase in, speed, effort, activity, emotion or development.



Synonyms: rise, increment

Antonyms: diminish, decrease

3. Quagmire (noun)

Meaning; A perilous, mixed up and troubled situation



Synonyms: dilemma, predicament

Antonyms: solution, contentment

4. **Proffer (verb)**

Meaning; An offer made



Synonyms: propose, offer

Antonyms: reject, deny

5. **Scrap (verb)**

Meaning; To discard.



Synonyms: abolish, abandon

Antonyms: restore, have

6. **Rejuvenate (verb)**

Meaning; To render young again



Synonyms: renew, revive

Antonyms: worsen, deplete

7. **Stringent (Adjective)**

Meaning; Strict; binding strongly
