1. Whine (verb)

Meaning; To make a sound resembling such a cry.



Synonyms: moan

Antonyms: pleasure

2. Recuperate (verb)

Meaning; To recover, especially from an illness



Synonyms: recover, improve

Antonyms: deteriorate, degrade

3. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate



Synonyms: count, calculate

Antonyms: ignore, miscalculate

4. Fawning (adjective)

Meaning; Seeking favor by way of flattery; flattering, servile



Synonyms: subservient, ingratiating

Antonyms: peremptory, domineering

5. Maverick (noun)

Meaning; Showing independence in thoughts or actions.



Synonyms: radical, dissenter

Antonyms: moderate

6. Consternation (noun)

Meaning; Amazement or horror that confounds the faculties, and incapacitates for reflection



Synonyms: anxiety, distress

Antonyms: pleasure, satisfaction

7. Prowess (noun)

Meaning; Distinguished bravery or courage,



Synonyms: expertise, ability

Antonyms: novice, inability
