### 1. Blockade (noun)

**Meaning;** The physical blocking or surrounding of a place to prevent commerce and traffic in or out.



**Synonyms:** barricade, barrier

**Antonyms:** access, open

### 2. Distract (adjective)

**Meaning;** absent-minded, troubled, distracted

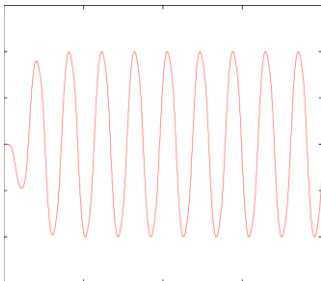


**Synonyms:** inattentive, careless

**Antonyms:** attentive, careful

### 3. Vacillate (verb)

**Meaning;** To sway unsteadily from one side to the other; oscillate.



**Synonyms:** oscillate

**Antonyms:** resolute

**4. Tinker (verb)**

**Meaning;** To tinker with; to tweak or attempt to fix.



**Synonyms:** fix, improve

**Antonyms:** destroy, mess

**5. Endeavor (noun)**

**Meaning;** A sincere attempt



**Synonyms:** attempt

**Antonyms:** leave

**6. Frenetic (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Fast, harried; having extreme enthusiasm or energy.



**Synonyms;** hectic, wild

**Antonyms;** tranquil, settled

**7. Dodder (verb)**

**Meaning;** To shake or tremble



**Synonyms:** stagger, stumble

**Antonyms:** stay, remain
