### 1. Interminable (adjective)

**Meaning;** Existing or occurring without interruption



**Synonyms:** endless, boundless

**Antonyms:** brief, interrupted

### 2. Unsavoury (adjective)

**Meaning;** Not savory; without flavor.



**Synonyms:** distasteful

**Antonyms:** tasteful

### 3. Inordinate (Adjective)

**Meaning;** Excessive; unreasonable or inappropriate in magnitude; extreme



**Synonyms:** excessive, unwarranted

**Antonyms:** modest, limited

**4. Tinker (verb)**

**Meaning;** To tinker with; to tweak or attempt to fix.



**Synonyms:** fix, improve

**Antonyms:** destroy, mess

**5. Succour (noun)**

**Meaning;** Aid, assistance, or relief



**Synonyms:** assist, aid

**Antonyms:** hurt, harm

**6. Hone (verb)**

**Meaning;** To make more acute, intense, or effective.



**Synonyms:** sharpen, edge

**Antonyms:** blunt, diminish

**7. Mellow (adjective)**

**Meaning;** subdued, soft, rich, delicate



**Synonyms:** melodious, Mellifluous

**Antonyms:** harsh, gruff
