

1. **Envisage (verb)**

Meaning; To conceive



Synonyms: visualise, conceive

Antonyms: real, actual

2. **Confound(verb)**

Meaning; To combine in a confused fashion



Synonyms: astound, baffle

Antonyms: explain, clarify

3. **Divulge (verb)**

Meaning; To make public or known



Synonyms: reveal

Antonyms: conceal

4. **Ablution (noun)**

Meaning; The act of washing or cleansing the body



Synonyms: clean

Antonyms: pollution

5. **Corpus (noun)**

Meaning; A collection of writings, a body, a collection.



Synonyms: compilation, collection

Antonyms: sole, individual

6. **Smidgen (noun)**

Meaning; A very small quantity or amount.



Synonyms: bit

Antonyms: lot

7. **Perfunctory (adjective)**

Meaning; Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless or indifferent manner



Synonyms: careless

Antonyms: careful
