2. **Trove (noun)**

3. **Deceive (verb)**

**Meaning;** To trick or mislead.



**Synonyms:** fraud

**Antonyms:** honest

4. **Fret (verb)**

**Meaning;** To chafe or irritate; to worry.



**Synonyms:** concern, discomfort

**Antonyms:** relax, comfort

5. **Fume (verb)**

**Meaning;** To express or feel great anger.



**Synonyms:** blow up

**Antonyms:** calm

6. **Jockey (verb)**

**Meaning;** To maneuver (something) by skill for one's advantage.
