**Antonyms:** restrain, deter

2. **Peter (verb)**

**Meaning;** To dwindle



**Synonyms:** decline, lessen

**Antonyms:** increase, enhance

3. **Leery (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Cautious, suspicious



**Synonyms:** suspicious, dubious

**Antonyms:** confidential, clear

**4. Recalcitrant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority



**Synonyms:** disobedient, rebellious

**Antonyms:** obedient, compliant

**5. Intrigue (verb)**

**Meaning;** A complicated or clandestine plot



**Synonyms:** conspire

**Antonyms:** expose

**6. Elide (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cut off



**Synonyms:** separate

**Antonyms:** separate

**Meaning;** To do without, to abandon, to renounce
