**Meaning;** Extremely dirty and unpleasant



**Synonyms:** unsavoury, improper

**Antonyms:** fitting, proper

2. **Incertitude (noun)**

**Meaning;** uncertainty, doubt, insecurity



**Synonyms:** confusion, suspicion

**Antonyms:** confirm, assurance

3. **Lousy (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Remarkably bad



**Synonyms:** bad, awful

**Antonyms:** good, nice

4. **Quittance (noun)**

**Meaning;** A release or acquittal.



**Synonyms:** requital

**Antonyms:** captivity

5. **Pillage (verb)**

**Meaning;** To loot or plunder by force



**Synonyms:** ransack, ravage

**Antonyms:** protect, defend

6. **Noxious (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Harmful; injurious.

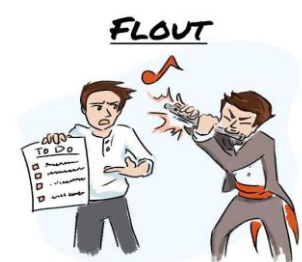


**Synonyms:** harmful, bad
