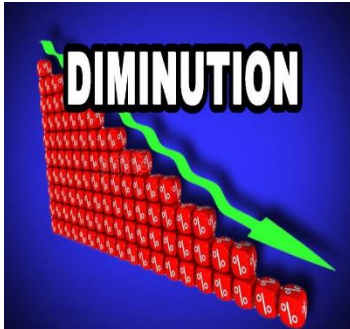


1. **Diminution (noun)**

**Meaning;** A lessening, decrease or reduction.



**Synonyms:** decrease, contraction

**Antonyms:** increase, expansion

2. **Dither (verb)**

**Meaning;** To be uncertain or unable to make a decision



**Synonyms:** hesitate, waver

**Antonyms:** decide, advance

3. **Fickleness (adjective)**

**Meaning;** The quality of being fickle/unreliable



**Synonyms:** disloyalty, variability

**Antonyms:** loyalty, stability

4. **Communique (noun)**

**Meaning;** An official report or statement



**Synonyms:** bulletin, posting

**Antonyms:** concealment, suppression

5. **Cleave (verb)**

**Meaning;** To split or sever something



**Synonyms:** split, divide

**Antonyms:** Unite, connect

6. **Seminal (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Highly influential



**Synonyms:** Influential, important

**Antonyms:** inessential, unsubstantial

7. **Fuelled (verb)**

**Meaning;** To exacerbate, to cause to grow or become greater.



**Synonyms:** encourage, boost

**Antonyms:** reduce, moderate
