

1. **Brace (verb)**

**Meaning;** To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.



**Synonyms:** fortify, strengthen

**Antonyms:** reduce, weaken

2. **Usher (verb)**

**Meaning;** to lead or guide somewhere



**Synonyms:** introduce, lead

**Antonyms:** cease, retract

3. **Panoply (adjective)**

**Meaning;** A splendid display of something.



**Synonyms:** exhibition

**Antonyms:** cover

**4. Incense (verb)**

**Meaning;** To anger or infuriate



**Synonyms:** anger, enrage

**Antonyms:** please, calm

**5. Acclaimed (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Greatly praised or lauded, revered, highly respected

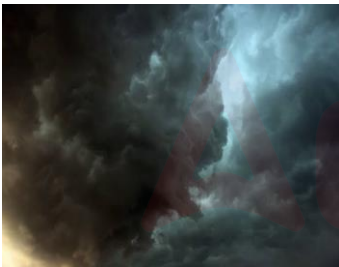


**Synonyms:** renowned

**6. Augury (noun)**
