

1. **Exigent (noun)**

Meaning; Urgent; needing immediate action



Synonyms: crucial, important

Antonyms: unimportant, invaluable

2. **Echelon (noun)**

Meaning; A level or rank in an organization, profession



Synonyms: grade, rank

Antonyms: unsettle, unemployment

3. **Coruscate (verb)**

Meaning; To give off light; to reflect in flashes; to sparkle



Synonyms: sparkle, shimmer

Antonyms: dull, dim

4. Plaintive (adjective)

Meaning; Sounding sorrowful, mournful



Synonyms: painful, pathetic

Antonyms: joyful, cheerful

5. Logjam (noun)

Meaning; A clog or such jam or mess that halts or greatly delays progress.



Synonyms: stagnation, deadlock

Antonyms: advance, expedition

6. Abysmal (adjective)

Meaning; extremely bad; terrible.



Synonyms: awful, bad

Antonyms: good, nice

7. Fidgety (adjective)

Meaning; Having, or pertaining to, a tendency to fidget; restless



Synonyms: uneasy, restless

Antonyms: calm, tranquil
