

1. **Coruscate (verb)**

Meaning; To give off light; to reflect in flashes; to sparkle



Synonyms: sparkle, shimmer

Antonyms: dull, dim

2. **Spur (verb)**

Meaning; Anything that inspires or motivates



Synonyms: propel, excite

Antonyms: halt, dissuade

3. **Connivance (noun)**

Meaning; The process of conniving or conspiring.



Synonyms: involvement, intrigue

Antonyms: rejection

4. Reticence (noun)

Meaning; a silent and reserved nature



Synonyms: reluctance

Antonyms: frankness

5. Scapegoat (noun)

Meaning; Someone punished for the error or errors of someone else.



Synonyms: victim

Antonyms: culprit

6. Farrago (noun)

Meaning; A collection containing a confused variety of miscellaneous things.



Synonyms: jumble

Antonyms: sequence

7. Stalwart (noun)

Meaning; One who is dependable.



Synonyms: reliable

Antonyms: unreliable
