**Meaning;** A leave of absence or vacation



**Synonyms:** recess, break

**Antonyms:** recall, travail

2. **Wrest (verb)**

**Meaning;** To seize.



**Synonyms:** snatch, grab

**Antonyms:** release, give

3. **Pander (verb)**

**Meaning;** To make illicit or illegal offer



**Synonyms:** gratify, indulge

**Antonyms:** refuse, dissatisfy

**4. Cadence (noun)**

**Meaning;** Balanced, rhythmic flow

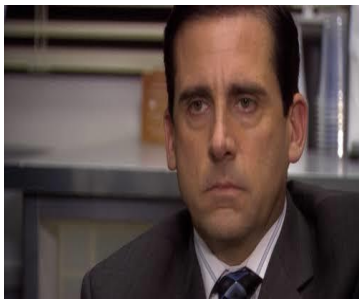


**Synonyms;** beat, rhythm

**Antonyms;** chaotic, orderless

**5. Ogle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To stare at (someone or something), especially impertinently, amorously, or covetously.



**Synonyms:** stare

**Antonyms:** ignore

**6. Waylay (verb)**

**Meaning;** To lie in wait for and attack from ambush.



**Synonyms:** ambushade

**Antonyms:** forward

**7. Insouciant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Casually unconcerned



**Synonyms:** unworried, carefree

**Antonyms:** worried, concerned
