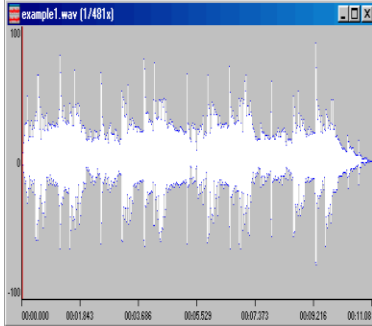


1. **Distortion (noun)**

Meaning; Noise or other artifacts caused in the electronic reproduction of sound or music.



Synonyms: disruption, interruption

Antonyms: clear, perfect

2. **Aghast (adjective)**

Meaning; Terrified; struck with amazement



Synonyms: surprised, anxious

Antonyms: unsurprised, calm

3. **Embezzlement (noun)**

Meaning; The fraudulent conversion of property from a property owner.



Synonyms: fraud, theft

Antonyms: honest, return

4. **Nimble (adjective)**

Meaning; Quick-witted and alert.



Synonyms: clever, alert

Antonyms: dull, dorky

5. **Equanimity (noun)**

Meaning; the state of being calm, stable and composed



Synonyms: calmness

Antonyms: discomfort

6. **Reckon (verb)**

Meaning; To count; to enumerate



Synonyms: count, calculate

Antonyms: ignore, miscalculate

7. **Revere (verb)**

Meaning; to regard someone or something with great awe or devotion.



Synonyms: respect

Antonyms: criticise
