Synonyms: judicious, Shrewd

Antonyms: imprudent, unwise

2. Humdrum (adjective)

Meaning; Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



Synonyms: boring

Antonyms: exciting

3. Brace (verb)

Meaning; To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.



Synonyms: fortify, strengthen

Antonyms: reduce, weaken

4. **Incense (verb)**

Meaning; To anger or infuriate



Synonyms: anger, enrage

Antonyms: please, calm

5. **Ostensibly (noun)**
