

1. Decency (noun)

Meaning; The quality of being decent; propriety.



Antonyms: indecency, impropriety

Synonyms: molarity, propriety

2. Genre(noun)

Meaning; A kind; a stylistic category or sort, especially of literature or other artworks.

Realistic Fiction A story that happens in real life.	Historical Fiction A story that is set in the past but is not actually historical.	Science Fiction A story that is set in the future and involves advanced technology.
Fantasy A story that involves magic and mythical creatures.	Mystery A story that involves a crime or a puzzle that needs to be solved.	Poetry A form of literature that is written in a rhythmic and metaphorical style.
Tall Tale A story that is exaggerated and often impossible.	Fairy Tale A story that involves a prince, a princess, and magical creatures.	Myth A story that is part of a culture's beliefs and traditions.
Fable A short story that teaches a moral lesson.	Legend A story that is based on historical events but is often exaggerated.	Informational A story that provides information about a specific topic.

4. **Quaint (Adjective)**

Meaning; Strange or odd; unusual.



Synonyms; peculiar, strange

Antonyms; common, ordinary

5. **Summon(verb)**

Meaning; To call people together; to convene.



Antonyms; send, ignore

Synonyms; ask, order

6. **Inferno (noun)**

Meaning; A large fire, a conflagration.



Antonyms; ordered, disciplined

Synonyms; disordered, tumultuous

7. **Stagger(verb)**

Meaning; Doubt, waver, be shocked.



Antonyms; usual, simple

Synonyms; surprising, astounding
