2. **Drub (verb)**

**Meaning;** To beat

3. **Morose (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Sullen, gloomy; showing a brooding ill humour.



**Synonyms:** sullen

**4. Harp (verb)**

**Meaning;** To repeatedly mention a subject.
