

1. **Sidle (verb)**

Meaning; To (cause something to) move sideways



Synonyms: sneak, slide

Antonyms: march, ride

2. **Attune (verb)**

Meaning; to bring into harmony or accord.



Synonyms: harmonize, acclimatize

Antonyms: disharmonize, destabilise

3. **Precarity (noun)**

Meaning; condition of existence without predictability



Synonyms: unpredictability, uncertainty

Antonyms: predictability, certainty

4. Dither (verb)

Meaning; To be uncertain or unable to make a decision



Synonyms: hesitate, waver

Antonyms: decide, advance

5. Fickleness (adjective)

Meaning; The quality of being fickle/unreliable



Synonyms: disloyalty, variability

Antonyms: loyalty, stability

6. Obfuscation (noun)

Meaning; Confusion, bewilderment, or a baffled state



Synonyms: confusion

Antonyms: illumination

7. Conflagration (noun)

Meaning; A large fire extending to many objects, or over a large space; a general burning.



Synonyms: fire

Antonyms: smoke
