**Meaning;** without the knowledge of



**Synonyms:** unknown, unaware

**Antonyms:** known, aware

2. **Inferno (noun)**

**Meaning;** A large fire, a conflagration.



**Synonyms:** disordered, tumultuous

**Antonyms:** ordered, disciplined

3. **Frenetic (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Fast, harried; having extreme enthusiasm or energy.

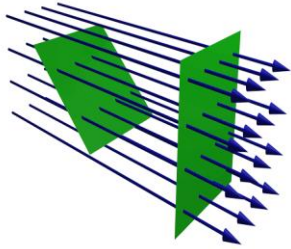


**Synonyms:** hectic, wild

**Antonyms:** tranquil, settled

4. **Flux(noun)**

**Meaning;** The act of flowing; a continuous moving on or passing by
