

1. **Abeyance (noun)**

**Meaning;** Suspension; temporary suppression



**Synonyms:** hold, deferred

**Antonyms:** continue, resume

2. **Rescind (verb)**

**Meaning;** To repeal, annul, or declare void



**Synonyms:** abolish

**Antonyms:** approve

3. **Acrimony (noun)**

**Meaning;** A sharp and bitter hatred.

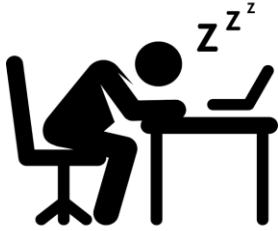


**Synonyms:** bitterness, hatred

**Antonyms:** compassion, love

4. **Dawdle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To spend (time) without haste or purpose.



**Synonyms:** delay, linger

**Antonyms:** expedite, hasten

5. **Grandeur (noun)**

**Meaning;** The state of being grand or splendid; magnificence.



**Synonyms:** magnificence, greatness

**Antonyms:** ordinary, simple

6. **Inroads (noun)**

**Meaning;** an incursion, an attempted invasion

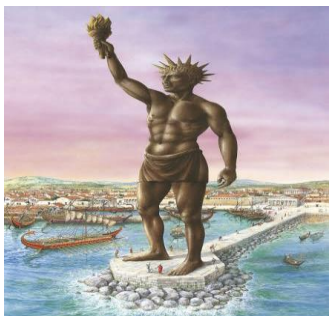


**Synonyms:** assault, strike
