**Meaning;** extremist, irrational



**Synonyms;** biased, orthodox

**Antonyms;** Liberal, unprejudiced

2. **Cadence (noun)**

**Meaning;** Balanced, rhythmic flow



**Synonyms;** beat, rhythm

**Antonyms;** chaotic, orderless

3. **Efface (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cause to disappear as if by rubbing out or striking out.



**Synonyms;** destroy, abolish

**Antonyms;** retain, protect

**4. Novice(noun)**

**Meaning;** A beginner



**Synonyms;** beginner, learner

**Antonyms;** trained, expert

**5. Recrimination(noun)**

**Meaning;** A counter or mutual accusation.



**Synonyms;** accusation, blame

**Antonyms;** acceptance, assent

**6. Piquant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Favorably stimulating



**Synonyms;** stimulating, fascinating

**Antonyms;** dull, zestless

**7. Reprobate (noun)**

**Meaning;** Immoral, having no religious or principled character.



**Synonyms;** villain, Rogue

**Antonyms;** righteous, principled
