2. **Dampen (verb)**

**Meaning;** To depress; to check



**Synonyms;** diminish, moderate

**Antonyms;** incite, ignite

3. **Perish (verb)**

**Meaning;** To decay and disappear;



**Synonyms;** disappear, crumble

**Antonyms;** appear, build

**4. Apposite (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Strikingly appropriate or relevant



**Synonyms;** suitable, relevant

**Antonyms;** unsuitable, irrelevant

**5. Lockstep (noun)**

**Meaning;** emulation of other's action



**Synonyms;** adhere, follow

**Antonyms;** defy, ignore

**6. Carnage (noun)**

**Meaning;** Death and destruction



**Antonyms;** peace

**Meaning;** Not intentional; not on purpose
