

1. **Abeyance (noun)**

**Meaning;** Suspension; temporary suppression



**Synonyms;** suspension, postponed

**Antonyms;** resume, restart

2. **Allude (verb)**

**Meaning;** To refer to something indirectly



**Synonyms;** mention, hint

**Antonyms;** conceal, Ignore

3. **Mire(noun)**

**Meaning;** An undesirable situation



**Synonyms;** entangle, embroil

**Antonyms;** release, assist

4. **Precarity (noun)**

**Meaning;** condition of existence without predictability or security



**Synonyms;** uncertain, risky

**Antonyms;** secure, safe

5. **Abstemious (adjective)**

**Meaning;** used with temperance or moderation.

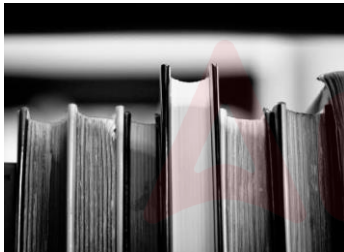


**Synonyms;** moderate, temperate

**Antonyms;** rapacious, intemperate

6. **Corpus (noun)**

**Meaning;** A collection of writings, a body, a collection.



**Antonyms;** sole, individual

**Synonyms;** compilation, collection

7. **Truce(noun)**

**Meaning;** an agreement between opposed parties in which they pledge to cease fighting for a limited time



**Synonyms;** peace, break

**Antonyms;** hostility, fighting
