

1. **Ample (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Fully sufficient; abundant; plenty



**Synonyms;** sufficient, abundant

**Antonyms;** insufficient, inadequate

2. **Lethargy (noun)**

**Meaning;** A state of extreme torpor or apathy, especially with lack of emotion or interest



**Synonyms;** inactivity, slowness

**Antonyms;** activity, enthusiasm

3. **Clumsy(adjective)**

**Meaning;** Awkward, lacking coordination



**Synonyms;** graceless, awkward

**Antonyms;** graceful, dignified

**4. Inexorable (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Unable to be persuaded; relentless; unrelenting.



**Synonyms;** relentless, unpreventable

**Antonyms;** merciful, exorable

**5. Quaint (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Strange or odd



**Synonyms;** strange, peculiar

**Antonyms;** Normal, usual

**6. Valedictory (noun)**

**Meaning;** A farewell or parting address.



**Synonyms;** farewell, depart

**Antonyms;** Welcome, entrance

**7. Slam(verb)**

**Meaning;** To speak badly of; to criticize forcefully.



**Synonyms;** denounce, rebuke

**Antonyms;** applaud, compliment
